1 About

It is oftentimes necessary to save documents that contain hyperlinks into a <u>Portable Document Format</u> (or PDF file) in order to easily and consistently convey information across multiple <u>multimedia</u> platforms (like different <u>operating systems</u>, <u>hardware devices</u>, <u>et cetera</u>).

Likewise, such documents (particularly webpages that have been converted into a PDF format) can contain hyperlinks that are of a sensitive or non-pertinent nature, thus such information is generally best removed from the converted document prior to publication (noting that some <u>security exploits</u> can be introduced through the inclusion of hyperlinks within a PDF file).

While there are many tools available to achieve this particular objective (some are better than others), most require user interaction with a <u>graphical user interface</u> (or GUI) and such user requirements are unideal for batch processing.

Conversely, as a result of this particular attribute, I created a simplistic <u>python</u> script to <u>programmatically</u> remove hyperlinks from PDF files.
